# CAMP DREAMCATCHER NEWS

YEAR-ROUND PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN WHOSE  
LIVES HAVE BEEN TOUCHED BY HIV/AIDS

**G**reetings:

2013 has already been a busy year for Camp Dreamcatcher. We launched two new programs this year:

- The “Paul Harris Human Potential Scholarship” applications were distributed during the 2012 camp session to college bound teens and young adults. The scholarship was established by Doug Harris, one of our volunteers, in honor of his Uncle Paul. The fund will provide two yearly \$1,000 scholarships to HIV/AIDS impacted youth served by Camp Dreamcatcher. The winners, Tranessa and Tyrell, were notified in April and were chosen because they have demonstrated positive leadership and service in their own communities and at Camp Dreamcatcher.
- The Mentoring Program was launched on June 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> at our first training weekend. This unique program will match one mentee (a previous camper) to one mentor (a counselor) for a one year commitment. The 10 mentors and 10 mentees will work toward specific goals and will be supported by Camp Dreamcatcher staff and will attend ongoing trainings.

Spring is the time for fundraising events at Camp Dreamcatcher!! The West Chester University Greek community held numerous events in April to support our programs. Camp Dreamcatcher Board Member Seth Birch once again organized the KDR Alumni Golf Tournament on April 27<sup>th</sup> and our Spring Event was held at Dansko on May 18<sup>th</sup>. These events raised over \$47,000 to support our programs and I want to thank the donors, volunteers, students and attendees for their dedication and generosity.

Our challenge this year is to raise enough funds to support the number of children interested in attending the camp session. We currently have 110 children registered for the camp session and we would like to be able to accept 20 additional children. We need to raise an additional \$9,400 to reach that goal. I hope that you can help us by making a donation in support of the camp program. There are so many ways to donate to Camp Dreamcatcher! We will launch the 3<sup>rd</sup> Groupon Grassroots Campaign on July 15<sup>th</sup> and for one week you can make donations through this program in \$10 increments.
