YEAR-ROUND PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN WHOSE LIVES HAVE BEEN TOUCHED BY HIV/AIDS

Dear Friends:

This is our annual Donor Newsletter for the 2016 fiscal year. My heart is full of gratitude as I read the hundreds of donor names listed on the pages of the newsletter.

I am happy to report that we achieved the following goals in 2016/2017:

- **Camp Session:** We served **132** youth during the 2016 camp session and provided 66 therapeutic, 40 educational and 120 recreational programs. **236** counselors, medical personnel, professionals and community members volunteered during the 2016 camp session.
- **Teen Leadership Retreat:** The 2016 & 2017 retreats were held on the Chesapeake Bay at NorthBay and served 45 participants.
- **HIV/AIDS Education and Community Outreach:** Camp Dreamcatcher staff and volunteers provided outreach to **50** sites and reached **10,000** people in 2016.
- **Adopt-a-Family Program:** This annual program is held in November and December each year. In 2016, the program provided over **1,500** gifts to **130** children.
- **100%** of the youth served by Camp Dreamcatcher are from low-income households and only **15%** have access to affordable therapeutic programs in their own communities.
- **THE TOTAL NUMBER OF VOLUNTEER HOURS SINCE INCEPTION IS 195,000**

Since our founding in 1996, our goal has been to expand our services to meet the changing needs of HIV/AIDS impacted youth. We are doing this once again in 2017 by launching two new programs. The first is the **Youth Advisory Board (YAB)**. This group, which will include teens and young adults that are currently involved in our programs, will meet with our Board of Directors during the camp session in August; and will provide feedback on current programs and policies. The second is the **Ambassadors of Hope Program**, which will include HIV/AIDS impacted young adults, who may or may not currently participate in our programs. This added program will give participants an opportunity to reconnect and receive ongoing support from the Camp Dreamcatcher family. The program will include training sessions on public speaking, as well as, an invitation to join us in providing HIV/AIDS education and outreach. The primary goal

is to empower teens and young adults to transition into leadership roles within Camp Dreamcatcher; and to assist in sustaining the organization's mission based services.

I lost two of my heroes this year. My sister-in-law, Lesley Darman, supported Camp Dreamcatcher in so many ways and for many years. Her love of animals inspired her wonderful coworkers at Drury Design Dynamics to create a fund in Lesley's memory in support of equine assisted mindfulness therapy and animal assisted therapies at Camp Dreamcatcher. **The Lesley Darman Equine and Small Animal Assisted Therapy Program** will be launched during the camp session in August and you can read more about this inside the newsletter.

Camp Dreamcatcher lost a driving force when **Charlotte Bartlett** passed away recently. It was Charlotte who encouraged (some may say forced) me to create Camp Dreamcatcher in 1996. Charlotte's never-ending belief in my ability to make my dream a reality carried me forward in the early days of Camp Dreamcatcher. She was dedicated to our mission of providing therapeutic programs to support children coping with HIV/ AIDS. Charlotte and I were co-therapists for many years and we always started our group sessions in a circle. Our therapeutic room at camp will now be named "**Charlotte's Circle**" in honor of her loving spirit.

Our **ANNUAL FUNDRAISING EVENT** will be held **ON JUNE 11th**. The event will feature a session with Psychic Medium: Joseph Tittel. You don't want to miss the opportunity to meet Joseph and to hear his messages from those who have passed. More information can be found in this newsletter. Currently, we are getting ready for the **22nd Therapeutic and Educational Camp Session**, which will take place **August 20th - 26th** at Camp Saginaw. We are in need of volunteers; the applications for which can be found on our website. Please feel free to call our office at 610-925-2998 for further details. I hope you can come out and join us for the session and meet the children benefiting from your support. It is only by visiting us at camp that you will realize the magic of Camp Dreamcatcher and the life changing difference you are making by supporting our programs.
