## TRAINING OPTIONS

### Introduction to RP One 2-hour session

This training lays the foundation for building a restorative community by introducing and exploring restorative principles and concepts, proactive community building strategies and a non-punitive approach for responding to harm through the lens of repairing relationships and restoring community.

### Intro + Deeper Dive into RP One 2-hour session + One 4-hour session

## UNDERLYING PREMISE

"The underlying premise of restorative practices is that people are happier, more cooperative, more productive and more likely to make positive changes when those in positions of authority do things WITH them rather than TO them or FOR them." (Ted Watchel, IIRP)

## RESTORATIVE PRACTICES

are based on principles and processes that emphasize the importance of trusting relationships as central to building community and repairs/restores relationships when harm has occurred.

## THIS APPROACH

views behavior infractions as an offense against individuals and the greater community, and places greater emphasis on the harm caused and reparation of relationships/community above the need for assigning blame and dispensing punishment.
